Then go back through the middle room to the room on the right where all the haunted houses, vendors, animatronics, goodies for sale were. They had people dressed up in character from different haunted houses and places going around scaring people and taking you to their booths. It was such a fun experience. Everyone, all the vendors, actors, and enthusiasts were all having a good time and enjoying each other's like minded spirits and minds.
